The region contained about 700 monasteries in the second half of the fourth century AD. Therefore, the area is considered one of the most honored areas for the followers of the Coptic Orthodox Church first Christian monastic congregation on the land of Wadi al-Natrun dates back to the fourth century AD at the hands of Makar al-Kabir who established the Monastery of St. Maqqar, so far along with three other monasteries, namely: the Monastery of Anba Bishoy, the Monastery of El-Baramous, and the Monastery of Syrian.

Start your tour visit Monastery of Anba Bishoy date the monastery dates back to its early beginnings of fourth century A.D., the place of the monastery was a group of Qalali or Monk Ceils (which is the residence of the monks) and a church in the middle surrounding the rocky cave in which Anba Bishoy lived without building walls. The wall been built to protect the church and the Monks ceils from the Barbarians attack who used to come attack the monks from time to time to stole everything the monks safe the Monastery now has an area of about two acres, and includes five churches, the largest of which is the "Anba Bishoy Church". It is the largest church in Wadi Natrun, next to a guesthouse, a spacious garden, a library, an archaeological table, and the Well of Martyrs, along with many Monks Ceils a few meters away from the Monastery of Anba Bishoy you will move to the monastery of the Syriac The smallest monastery from the four monasteries located at Wadi al-Natrun This monastery was found in the sixth century AD, the monastery built take the shape of Noah's Ark the monastery is called first as the Virgin Mary then a group of The Syrian monks comes and live in

the Monastery from the late eighth century until the sixteenth century that is why the monastery called now as, "the monastery of the Syriac", the Monastery is famous with its Fortress that build to protect the monks from the Barbarian attacks It was built in the middle of the ninth century AD and is also considered the highest fortress in the Area . It is build with four floors unusually followed (three floors) and opens its door on the second floor and accesses it with a bridge of wood based on one of its ends on the door of the fort and from the other on a building opposite the stairs, then It rises as necessary with iron chains.

Next you will move to the Monastery of El-Baramous It was founded c. 335 A.D. by Saint Macarius the Great The name Pa-Romeos or that of the Romans may refer to Saints Maximus and Domitius, children of the Roman Emperor Valentinian I, who had their cell at the place of the modern monastery. According to Coptic tradition, the two saints went to Scetes during the time of Saint Macarius the Great, who tried in vain to dissuade them from staying. Nevertheless, they stayed and attained perfection before dying at a young age.

On your back you will visit the Monastery of St. Maqqar The monastery was founded in approximately 360 AD by Saint Macarius of Egypt who was the spiritual father to more than 4,000 monks of different nationalities. The monastery has been continuously inhabited by monks since its 4th-century founding. the monastery is famous with the crypt of Saint John the Baptist and that of Elisha the Prophet the story of founding this crypt is they found by luck while the monks restoring the of the big Church of Saint Macarius, they discovered below the northern wall of the church, in accordance with the site mentioned in manuscripts from the 11th and 16th centuries found in the library of the monastery. This is also confirmed by the ecclesiastical tradition of the Coptic Orthodox Church. The relics were gathered in a special reliquary and placed before the sanctuary of Saint John the Baptist in the church of Saint Macarius.

No sooner had she come across Tunis than she decided to build her own country house there. The house was built in a domed- ceiling design, using environment-friendly building materials. It apparently was inspired by the designs of Hassan Fathi, dean of contemporary Egyptian architects. Being a masterwork of eco architecture, the potter's house encouraged others to build their houses in Tunis following the same pattern. She started her pottery studio in her new country house. At the very beginning, the village children would come – out of curiosity- to see what is going on. Some of them appeared very interested in Evelyn's work, which encouraged her to help them unearth their talents. Consequently, she established a pottery school Gradually, the ordinary village turned into a reputable center of a modern pottery and an open air museum of both eco and traditional rural buildings, which attracted investors and entrepreneurs who began to provide the village with different facilities.
